In case you pay your participation fee yourself, please enter your name and hannelius. If you are paying on behalf of another player, enter the participant's name and hannelius.

The participation fee is 85 euros for “early birds” registering before 31th of January. For players registering between 1.2.2026- 30.4.2026 the participation fee is 150 €. Participation fee is 200 € in case registration is made on 1.5.2026-26.6.2026. Fee includes coffee, tea and water during the tournament. (GM/WGM: no fee; IM/WIM 100 €)

In case the registration is cancelled participation fee will be refunded by 31th of July.

The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of players by closing the registration before the deadline if necessary. Maximum number of players is around 120 players.

Prizes: In case 100 players will participate, the organizer guarantees a total prize fund of min. 10 500 €. The distribution of the prize fund will be announced before the start of the 3rd round.

Other: All players must confirm their participation on Monday by contacting the organizer.

Electronic devices are not allowed in the playing area and must be handed to the organizers before entering the playing area. Randomized fair-play checks may be conducted before the start of the round.

Players registered under Russian or Belarusian chess federation are not allowed to participate to the competition due to the policy of the Finnish Chess Federation. Minors are exempted from this policy.

Default time is 30 minutes.
